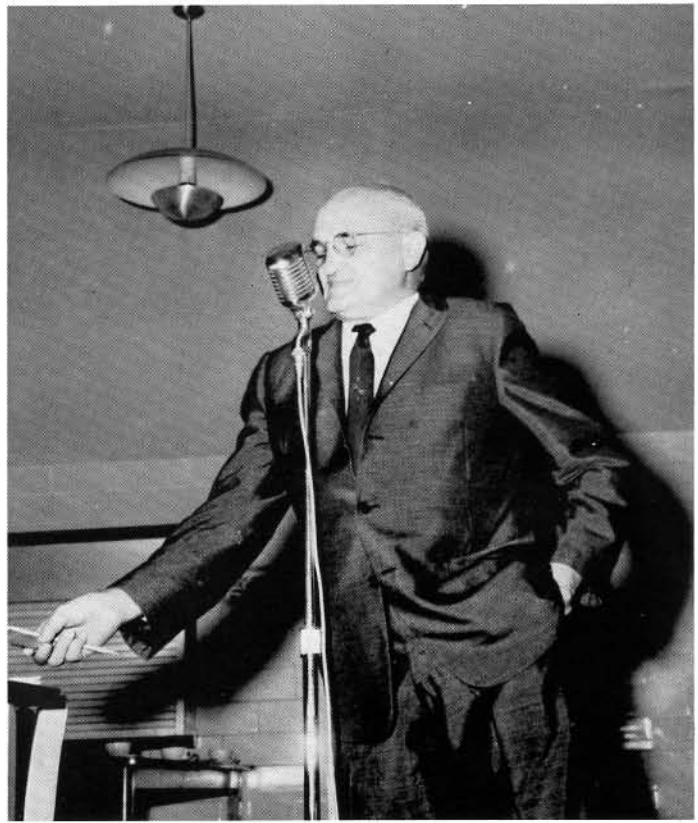


Our Special Friend

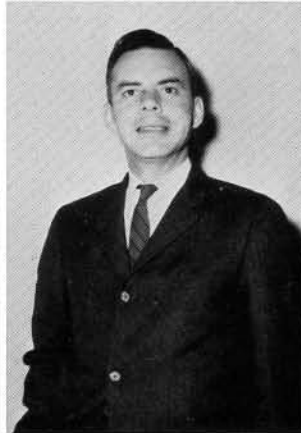
